

## Summary of “Life after COVID-19” Survey Results

### *Return to church date:*

- Less than one-third of respondents feel prepared to interact with general public on May 15
- Less than one-quarter are ready to return to church on Sunday, May 17, but this rises to almost **one-half (47.1%) by June 7**. Two (of 55) respondents will not return while masks are required.
- A very large number (44/55) would like to continue our online worship services for the foreseeable future (at least mid-July most mentioned in comments, particularly for those >65 or who follow stricter guidelines)

### *Precautions desired by majority (>50%):*

- Regular sanitizing of touched surfaces
- Hand sanitizer stations
- Marked-off pews
- Masks available
- Change of communion procedures
- Change of dismissal/departure

### *Communion:*

- Pre-packaged, sealed, wafer/juice kits - highest comfort level
- Pre-packaged also has a high *uncomfortable* level, but unclear if it is practice or delivery cause

### *Online offerings*

- Very high (~85% rated 8-10) experience rating for Sunday worship online
- Very high (~85% rated 8-10) experience rating for Mon-Thurs devotionals
- High (~70% several or every evening) usage of evening prayers
