

WEAR A MASK

Please keep your mask on when entering or exiting the sanctuary, and at all times (except during communion) if seated on the mask-required side.



USE HAND SANITIZER

Bottles are located at each entrance and exit, in the restrooms, and elsewhere.

COOKS and DRIVERS needed! As we do what we can to help our church family who are recovering from medical issues, we are developing a **First Christian Church Meal Ministry**.

This ministry will address those within our church community whose **temporary need for meal assistance due to medical issues** is not already being met through their involvement in a church group, family, or friends.

You may bring a frozen meal by the church office during business hours, to be labelled and stored in our freezers until called for, or sign up for prep of a ready-to-eat meal on an as-needed basis. Depending on the recipient's needs and physical restrictions, delivered meals may be frozen, or ready-to-eat.
