UPCOMING GUEST SPEAKERS

- Sunday, November 14 Rev. Laura Phillips-Peters was formerly an Associate Pastor at FCCBRLA, and went to Overland Park Christian Church in March 2013 as the Associate Pastor. In August of 2017 OPCC called Laura to serve as the Senior Pastor, the first woman to do so in OPCC's history. While at FCCBRLA, Laura was actively involved in leading and developing youth congregational growth, and in guiding a group of girls at Runnels school. No matter the ministry of the church, Laura seeks to create a safe and inviting place for all who are seeking, questioning, doubting, and looking for a relationship with God, no matter where they are on their journey. Ordained in 2009, Laura attended Lexington Theological Seminary and the University of Missouri. Her background and faith journey has colored her commitment to peace, social justice, outreach, and the many different ways in which people can experience God uniquely and authentically.
- Sunday, November 21 The Rev. Dedrick "DJ" Minor known to his friends and family as simply "DJ" is someone that many of you may recognize. He has worked as a clinical chaplain in various healthcare settings for nearly 20 years and is currently a chaplain at Our Lady of the Lake. Dedrick received a Bachelors from Oral Roberts University in New Testament Theology and Business Administration, a Masters of Divinity from New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary, and will receive a Doctor of Ministry (with the specialization in Pastoral Counseling) this December from New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary. He was ordained by the Disciples of Christ in 2011 during his three-year tenure as associate pastor at Olive Branch Ministries of GNO Kenner. As a preacher's kid, Dedrick grew up in the church and started preaching at the age of 15. He also shared that he enjoys good coffee, jazz (even named his dog after Miles Davis), reading, writing, cooking, and basketball (life long Duke Blue Devil fan).
- Sunday, November 28 Rev. Cheryl Russell, who accepted her call to ministry while living in Baton Rouge and active at First Christian Church. She shares: I grew up in

Central Indiana and found my way to Baton Rouge, Louisiana in 2007. I taught middle school outside Baton Rouge for three years and during that time I was an active member of First Christian Church, Baton Rouge. It was during my time worshiping and serving alongside the wonderful people at FCCBRLA that I finally accepted my call to ministry. I am forever grateful for the friendship and the nurturing I received from this congregation! When I left Baton Rouge, I got my Master of Divinity from Vanderbilt Divinity School in Nashville, TN. I was ordained in 2013 in the church that raised me in Zionsville, IN. I have been serving churches as either an associate or senior minister since. Currently, I am serving as Interim Senior Minister at First Christian Church in Kokomo, IN and living in Noblesville, IN. My favorite thing to do is to spend time with my two nieces and nephew. I also enjoy playing golf, listening to podcasts, and making gumbo like I learned during my time in Cajun Country.

We look forward to hearing and appreciating the different gifts each of these preachers will be sharing with us in the coming weeks.

PARDON OUR PROGRESS

You might notice some work crews out at our church in the near future. As some of you are aware, we discovered a gas leak earlier this year but it's been a rather involved process to pin down the exact problem and something that both Finance and the Board have been aware of and working on for some time now. The work has been done in stages with discussion and evaluation after each stage and, unfortunately, the issue did turn out to be with the pipes running underground.

Rather than tear up the concrete in the courtyard to locate and solve the problem, the decision was made to instead run new gas lines through the attics of the affected buildings. The gas lines provide heat to these buildings, which include the office, the fellowship hall and the nursery, so getting this done before winter was always the goal. We are pleased to let you know that this work will be commencing sometime over the next couple of weeks prior to Thanksgiving. It will likely take take up to two weeks to complete all the work, so should be wrapped up as we move into Advent.
