


Turn Your Eyes Upon Jesus

The following note to Rev. Dr. Minor is shared with the permission of the author..

Dear Rev. Dedrick,

This is Janet Younathan, a former member of FCC Baton Rouge, now living in suburban Philadelphia. I met you when I was in Baton Rouge in May. I am compelled to write after your sermon on Sunday, August 14, 2022, which spoke a healing balm into my current circumstances.

On Saturday, August 6, I had a surprise visit to the emergency room, which culminated the next day in surgery to remove my gallbladder. God was indeed with me in the ER, the OR, and in my hospital room. I had surgery that was badly needed and am fine now, recuperating well at home.



A nurse in my congregation brought me home from the hospital on Monday, August 8.

She made the point that it is difficult to quantify pain, because we each have different tolerances for pain and experience it in different ways. I told her the greatest pain in all of this was not the pain from the gallbladder; it was the pain from multiple vomits, because the whole body contracts and lurches.

Later, God reminded me that Christ suffered with his whole body to redeem us. You described His whole-body sacrifice in a vivid and understandable way. What I had not heard before was the interpretation of "the joy that was set before him" in Hebrews 12:2. I had read in the past that this joy was the joy of Jesus' future rule or His exaltation, but I see that the Reformation Study Bible interprets this joy as you do — "the joy of being Savior of His people".

The gospel makes us look at life completely differently than those who don't know it. What a comfort to know that Jesus is not "a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin" (Heb. 4:15). Jesus' redemptive work on the cross is finished, but his care for us will never be finished. He is our eternal shepherd, defender, and advocate. Indeed, He lives to intercede for us!

Thank you for this solid message to show us this Savior.
