### **DID YOU KNOW?**

As early as 1847, a Disciples congregation was founded in Baton Rouge which grew to the size of over 100 members by the next year. This pioneering group fared well until the devastating influence of the War Between the States, and the ensuing Reconstruction. The growing Disciples movement also went through many organizational splits and changes. On September 22, 1938, Perry F. Baldwin established a Christian Church in a meeting room at the old Holsum Bakery, and signed a charter. The current name was adopted in 1953, and having met in various locations through the years, the First Christian Church of Baton Rouge moved to its present site in 1964.
