# The Secret of Change

Socrates once said, "The secret of change is to focus all of your energy not on fighting the old, but on building the new."

A disturbing change in the 21st century is the closure of churches and the general movement of people away from church membership. About 4,500 Protestant churches closed in 2019, the last year data is available, according to Lifeway Research. Here in Louisiana, Disciples churches which have closed include Broadmoor Christian Church in Shreveport, St. Charles Avenue Christian Church in New Orleans and the Disciples church in Metairie. The pandemic accelerated this trend, and Protestant pastors have reported that church attendance is only at 85% of pre-pandemic levels. Another factor in declining church membership, especially for younger generations, is churches becoming too political and judgmental. About a quarter of the young adults who dropped out of church said in the Lifeway survey that they disagreed with their church's stance on political and social issues. I believe the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ). and particularly FCC-Baton Rouge, has much to offer people who want a politics-free church home, but I think we need to be much more intentional about telling our community what we offer. To that end, I am forming an evangelism committee which will be unlike any evangelism committee the church has ever had before. We're not going to knock on doors or adopt an evangelism program in a box from the denomination's office. This committee is going to look both inward and outward. We're going to think about who we are, whom we want to serve, and how we want to serve. Then, we'll consider how best to invite the community into our fellowship. This committee will probably be making the most important decisions this church has made since deciding to move to Old Hammond Highway in the 1950s, because it will be trying to ensure the church's continued existence, despite the headwinds of demographic changes. I need people with both vision and vitality for this committee, and I do not care how old you are. If you care about this church and want it to not just survive but grow, this committee needs you. Please call Carol Madere at 225-931-4413 to volunteer. We will start meeting in August. This committee will also need the congregation to support growth ideas and activities. It will take a whole of church effort to be effective. Can we count on you?
