Fellowship Hall Improvements

The generous donation, mentioned elsewhere in this newsletter, has enabled us to undertake the following improvements to the Fellowship Hall.

At the east end (the Foyer and Kitchen) areas:

- •The 40 year old + ceilings will be removed.
- •The 40 year old + HVAC ductwork will be replaced (the interior insulation has been failing).
- •New A/C diffusers will be installed.
- •A new lay-in acoustical tile ceiling will be installed.
- •New energy-efficient LED light fixtures will be installed.
- •The deteriorated folding partition that separates the Foyer from the main area will be removed.


At the west end (the classrooms):

- •The 40 year old + ceilings will be removed (some of which has fallen down).
- •A new lay-in acoustical tile ceiling will be installed.
- •New energy-efficient LED light fixtures will be installed.
- •This work is slated to begin November 27, 2023, and be concluded by January 26, 2024.


