"Getting dirty for Jesus" is back! Week of Compassion and the DoC Great River Region are partnering with "Rolling Fork Rising" to build new homes and create opportunities for home ownership for renters displaced by the EF-4 tornado that devastated Rolling Fork, MS in 2023. Work trips are being planned for the weeks of May 18-24 and May 25-31. The maximum group size is 20. Minimum age of participation is 14 years. (*Note: there must be 2 adults for every 5 minors.) Volunteers will be housed at the First Baptist Church of Rolling Fork, in classrooms that have been converted into bunk rooms. Meals will be prepared by the group. There is a registration cost of \$50/person/week. Space is limited, so please contact Judy Lester 225-221-4478, or the church office as soon as you can if you are interested in participating.

The Great River Regional Office of the Christian Church, Disciples of Christ has appointed Reverend Ronny Nowell to a newly formed position of "Regional Disaster Response Coordinator". Rev Nowell has been charged with forming a comprehensive disaster response plan for the Region. Listed below are some planning areas Rev Nowell would like to develop. However, it will take the participation of all the congregations in our region to build and staff a viable resource that can be counted on for support during times of natural disasters and operational disruption. If you have any interest in becoming involved in the development of these plans, or of volunteering to serve in any of these capacities once the functional areas are operational, please contact Judy Lester or the church office.

- 1. Building a regional "early response team"
- 2. Discerning interest and requirements for forming a "Crisis Emotional Support/Spiritual Care Team"
- 3. Forming and deploying "rebuild teams"
- 4. Identification of congregational assets and local preparedness/response partnerships
- 5. Form a "Disaster Recovery Advisory Council" with congregational representatives (attend VOAD Zoom calls, evaluate programs, etc.)
- 6. Develop a "Crisis Call Center" and recruit volunteers
