Week of Compassion and the DoC Great River Region are partnering with "Rolling Fork Rising" to build new homes and create opportunities for home ownership for renters displaced by the EF-4 tornado that devastated Rolling Fork, MS in 2023. Work trip space is still available for the week May 25-31. The maximum group size is 20. Minimum age of participation is 14 years. (*Note: there must be 2 adults for every 5 minors.) Volunteers will be housed at the First Baptist Church of Rolling Fork, in classrooms that have been converted into bunk rooms. Meals will be prepared by the group. Areas of involvement include, but are not limited to:


- 1. Early crisis response (support in the immediate aftermath)
