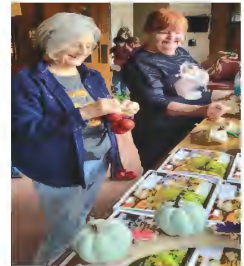

1	sweet onion, diced	¼	cup grated parmesan

¼	tsp cayenne pepper	1	bag broccoli flowerets
3	cups whole milk	1	cup cubed Velveeta
8	oz cream cheese		Sea salt and pepper

BROCCOLI RICE CASSEROLE

Cook broccoli. Cook rice. Saute onion and garlic in butter. Add remaining ingredients except rice and broccoli. Cook and stir until thick. Add rice and broccoli. Pour into greased casserole dish. Bake at 350 for 30 minutes.
